Previous Minutes: Minutes from January's meeting were presented. Motion to accept the minutes as amended made by Nancy and 2nd made by Barbara. Motion carried unanimously. Corrections: <u>Under Old Business</u>: Violations-2nd paragraph to read: Property owner at 700 Bantam Road was <u>invited</u> (taking out offered) to attend a Borough meeting to get his violations <u>resolved</u> (taking out done and add resolved)

Treasurer's Report & Paying of the Bills: A motion to pay bills made by Nancy and 2nd by Wendy. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

<u>Violations/ Blight Ordinance</u>: Dick told the board that the owner of 700 Bantam Road was issued a warrant and has to appear for court in March. Dick will stay in touch with Sam Kinkade for results. Patterson was sent a letter requesting plans for correcting blight violations by our March meeting. If there is no response, the board will discuss fines.

<u>Alain White Field</u>: There is a deed in the Town Hall for the transfer of that property from White Memorial Foundation to Bantam Civic Assoc. dated 1948 for the price of 1 dollar. Dick met with Bantam Fire Co. trustees, Fire Co. President Dan Mcphee and Dan Parsons from the Civic Assoc. Per Parson, the Fire Co. has a long term lease on the property to secure insurance from the town. The town wants to drop the insurance. Dick suggested that the Civic Assoc. get new members and expand the uses of the field so that the town has a reason to continue funding the insurance. Nancy volunteered for the assoc. and feels she can recruit more members. Dick will contact Dan Parsons to see what he has accomplished. The hall will be offered as a meeting place. More info will come at our next meeting.

Brown Field: Dick has heard rumors that on offer has been placed on the property at 940 Bantam Rd. He will call the realtor, John Gould, to confirm and offer our help with the environmental if requested.
